

Membership grades

All applications are individually assessed by, or on behalf of, the Executive Council.

Student

Student Members must be no less than 18 years old and undertaking full or part-time education within emergency management or related disciplines at under or post-graduate level.

Subscription: £35 per year.

Associate

Associate Members must be no less than 21 years old and, whilst not possessing the qualifications or experience to attain the grade of Member, support the objectives of the Institute.

Subscription: £40 per year.

Member

Member grade is for those practising or professionally involved in the emergency planning or disaster management disciplines.

Subscription: £50 per year.

Fellow

Fellows may be admitted subject to reaching the age of 25 and:

- i) having been a Member of the Institute for one year and whose experience and background are such that the Executive Council considers such an individual warrants admission as a Fellow; or
- ii) whom the Executive Council considers should be admitted in this grade given their background and experience.

Subscription: £60 per year.

Professional designations

Members are entitled to use the post-nominal designation, MICPEM and Fellows, FICPEM.

All individual subscriptions are subject to a £5 discount if paid by Direct Debit

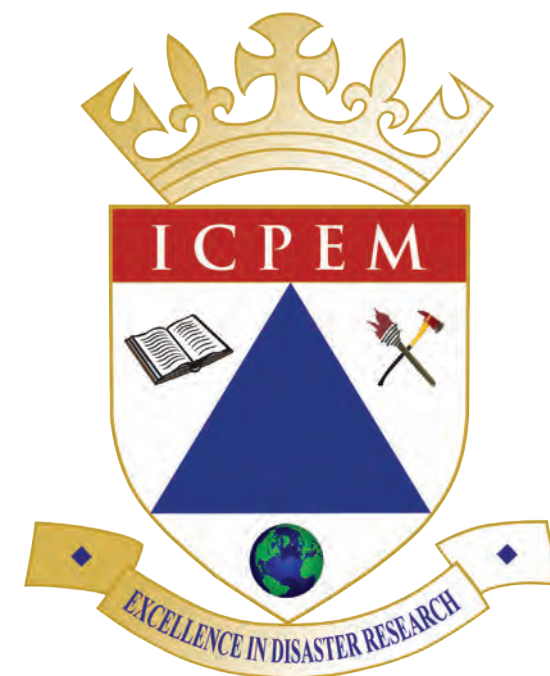
